Can you get hold of the statements or transcripts of interviews - referred to by Prof. Livesley in his list so we know they exist – for Brewer [Code A] and possible [Code A]. Also you should see the copy of the signed statement I made to the GMC which includes details of the conversations with Beed and Barton – some in the presence of Lesley and without revision to the previous papers. I cannot emphasize too strongly Barton did not explain syringe drivers nor was she present when Beed gave us the diagnosis of a massive haematoma and that my mother was dying. I certainly made it plain to Beed in Lesley's presence that I wanted my mother back at Haslar unless she was so close to dying that she could die in the ambulance – Beed replied "it is possible" and I therefore agreed to the syringe driver expecting my mother to die with an hour or two (as per Hamish) .

Any comeback from Horsley - I expect he has a "headache" and is not sure which way to jump but he has to look into the rumour now re. Barton's son and the way my complaints were handled under the jurisdiction of Readhead.

Isn't it rather odd that out of all the cases Barton checked with the coroner 3 days after my mother's death i.e. 24 August before she signed the death certificate. She already knew that we had raised complaints and I would suggest she was covering herself. I also find it odd that a death certificate in a hospital had to be signed by Barton only. I always queried why Couchman sent down the request for an X ray for my mother on the 17th. when Beed told us that "his" signature had not been accepted and he was the Clinical Manager – this was after he had given the first diamorphine injection. – Gillian
