Your GMC status

As a doctor registered with a licence to practise you must continue to abide by, and keep up to date with, the standards set out in *Good Medical Practice* and supplementary guidance. For example, it remains your professional duty to take out adequate insurance or professional indemnity cover for any part of your practice not covered by an employer's indemnity scheme.

Licensing is the first practical step towards the introduction of revalidation. When it is introduced (not before 2011), holding a licence will mean that you will need to demonstrate through periodic revalidation that you continue to comply with the relevant professional standards.
