I have been invited to attend an inquest on 3<sup>rd</sup> December at Portsmouth into the death of Mr Leslie Thomas Pink dob **Code A**

I was his usual General Practitioner for approximately 16 years.

I have attached:-

1. The Coroner's invitation to the inquest.
2. The letter I wrote to the Coroner's Officer in January 2009 in response to his enquiry for information. I have made an error in the letter in that I told the coroner I last saw the patient in October when in fact I saw him one week before his admission to Queen Alexandra hospital on 17.12.08 together with the Practice nurse..

I also omitted to mention his stable carcinoma of the prostate.

3. I attach the discharge summary from QAH, which showed his date of death and the summary of his medical problems at the time of death.
4. As you can see by the date of scanning into his notes, his discharge summary was not available to us when I wrote to the Coroner.
5. I attach the letter written by his Urology consultant at his last review appointment for his carcinoma prostate before his death.

I hope all this information is helpful.

Should I write to the Coroner and admit to the incorrect date on my letter as well as accepting his invitation to attend the inquest. Should I be accompanied?

This gentleman had been a patient of mine approximately since 1992. At that time he had a very minor stroke, was hypertensive and he remained with satisfactory blood pressure maintained on Aspirin 75mgs daily and Co-Tenidone 50 since that time.

He was the main carer of his wife for a number of years and remained looking after himself well after she died some years ago. He lived on his own in a little terraced house.

The history of his last complaint was; I saw him on 17 October in the surgery with painful varicose eczema which did not appear infected but was very itchy and I gave him some steroid cream and treated him with a compression liner. The next time he was seen was by one of the partners at home on 23 December when he was complaining of pain in the left hip and problems getting up out of his chair. She actually saw him get up from the chair but it appeared that he was in pain from the knee although it is red and not swollen. He was not able to look after himself and she mobilised the Multidisciplinary Team through the Single Point of Access. They saw him later on in the day but were unable to help and at that point I gather he was admitted to Queen Alexandra Hospital via the Medical Assessment Unit.

We have no other paperwork about what happened to him then and I am afraid this is a necessarily brief report about his last few weeks. I hope this is helpful.
