PHILIP JAMES BEED

I refer to my letter of 21 May 2001.

During the late afternoon of 21 May 2001, I attended a strategy meeting which was held at Fratton Police Station in connection with the investigation which is known as Operation Rochester. We have disclosed certain information to the General Medical Council and, having considered the matter further, it was felt appropriate to let you have copies of the statements of the daughters of the late Gladys Richards, any statement by Mr Beed, and the medical records of the late Gladys Richards.

You will see that I am copying this letter to Fratton Police Station and Detective Sergeant Sackman is making arrangements to send the appropriate papers direct to you. You will see that we do not accept that it is part of the Hampshire Constabulary's responsibilities to "complain" about any persons who are subject to regulation by the UKCC. Our task is solely to deal with any allegations of a criminal nature and we believe that we discharge our duty to you by keeping you in the picture with our enquiries.
