Sir

On the 27/06/2004 I spoke with [Code A], the grandson of Margaret Elizabeth BURT born 16/06/1914, died at the GWMH in 1998. In the last few months of her life Ian was the main carer for his grandmother despite being only 19 at the time and holding down a full time job. His own father (Frank) had died the year before, Mrs BURT's son and her daughters live abroad in Canada and Norway.

Ian was only able to give brief details about his grandmother, the size of the family she was born into is unknown but it believed all her siblings have died. Margaret married a naval man and had three children, June, Pauline and Frank (deceased). Her occupation is listed as housewife. Mrs BURT

Mrs BURT continued to live alone after the death of her son. However she took very poor care of herself and would become confused. She was initially admitted to Haslar Hospital (Aug 98) following a fall and suspected heart attack. She remained in hospital against her will and was transferred to the GWMH. By this stage her daughters returned from abroad to see their mother. This caused a family rift as the women did not feel Ian was doing enough to look after his grandmother.

During her stay at the GWMH Ian had no concerns and felt his grandmother was being well cared for. She was placed a drip because she had stopped eating altogether and is said to have tried to escape. Although he had little to do with his aunt in the latter stages of her life he states that his Aunt June did. She is described as a very particular women and the family feel that if something had been wrong she would have made mention of it.

Ian does not recall the exact date of death or what the cause for death was listed as. He does not feel that anything that happened would have made a great deal of difference but has asked to be updated with the FGM bulletin.
