I visited I [Code A], b.11/11/1919 at her home address [Code A] at 1000 hrs, 30/06/2004 in relation to her late sister Pamela Frances Blanche BROWN, b.08/06/1924.

Mrs BROWN was identified in Professor BAKER's report.

Mrs V [Code A] has a very poor memory and her recollection of the events leading to Pamela BROWN's death are extremely vague.

Pamela was born in Ascot, Berks. She was one of six children. Her three brothers died either in their early years or during the war and her other sister died in her 70's. Her parents, Frederick and Rose died in their 70's and 50's respectively.

Pamela was diagnosed with MS whilst in her early teens and initially her illness did not effect her working in the Land Army and then in a factory.

As she became older she lived with her sister and eventually went into the Redcliffe Annex. Pamela enjoyed being in the Redcliff Annex but wasn't happy when the Annex closed and the residents moved up to the main hospital site.

When Pamela went into hospital she wasn't ill but Doris was unable to cope with looking after her.

Mrs [Code A] recalls that Pamela died suddenly and she wasn't expecting it. She remembers the staff asking her if she wanted to stay the night and that this was her first indication that Pamela was will. She states that Pamela died the next day.

She says she didn't know what was wrong with Pamela but she didn't have any concerns at the time. However she clearly recalls a nurse saying to Pamela "Do you want to die with dignity". She says she felt sickened by this comment and recalls that Pamela acknowledged that she did.

Pamela is buried but [Code A] cannot recall where.
