The normal practice of caring for an individual within a life threatening situation would be to have a discussion with the relatives if the patient was not deemed to be able to be involved. Pain control is of great importance and the best way to effect this would be the use of a syringe driver with the appropriate drug. The use of intravenous fluids at this stage may be considered to be of no benefit, as they can often create more difficulties. Regular mouth care would ensure that the patient would not have to suffer from dryness of the mouth. The lack of intravenous infusion would not make a difference to the eventual outcome of this situation.
