I wrote a whole load of stories about the deaths at Gosport War Memorial Hospital for the Sindy (see attached file) - I understand that you covered the police case several years ago.
I am leaving in a month which means I am going to miss the final inquest in the case, that of Gladys Richards, 91, who died in 1998 - it was her daughter Gillian McKenzie who forced three police inquiries and the GMC to act. I have been working with Gillian, who is in her late 70s but brilliantly sharp and knowledgeable, for years and am gutted to be missing this.
It should be a really interesting hearing from 17-19 December, and could raise some very difficult questions for the police, Dr Jane Barton and the nurses involved.
It thought you would be the ideal person to take this over - if you're interested please let me know as I have all the documents and will pass on as much as I can.
