

① Why was a patient with a history of heart attack (2) leukiemia.

Put onto a ward in G.W.H.

were they do not have the suitable equipment or staff to deal with the medical needs from complication which generally happen to a at risk patient'

② Mum said at night when she needed the toilet - she couldn't make it so was told she had to share a commode as there was not enough for her to have one to herself.

URINE INFECTION *

③ when was mums blood pressure first noted at low -

Why wasn't she moved then.

* A lot of physical signs on Sepsic Shock - Had already occurred prior to this.

Question - Why was she put into G.W.H.

- Why wasn't she moved sooner?

- The ward she was put onto failed to notice she had all the symptoms of

SIRS failed to communicate with GP -

didn't talk to family about elements -

ignored family concerns

Result: Death

didn't do urine charts = urine test

" fluid charts

" Ignored fact she hadn't eaten or drunk adequate amounts for 7 days.

" dehydration? from diarrhoea + sickness
not taken into account.

NO samples taken for testing

did not communicate with DR Green ^{failed to confirm what mother had said -} lied

Just presumed illness was due to depression
