Dear Sir,

I have enclosed a copy of my formal complaint with regards Detective Superintendent John James and the supposed investigation he has now concluded into the death of my father and other elderly patients at the Gosport War Memorial Hospital.

I do not except his decision now, nor will I ever, I question both his competency and his integrity in coming to his decision.

I believe we have a clear case of systematic unlawful killing and it must be investigated to the full, with all persons connected, both relatives and staff, being interviewed and questioned. At the end of the investigation the findings should be made public or at least made available to those that matter, and any criminal or negligent charges should be dealt with by the courts.

I live in your constituency my father was unlawfully killed in it, I believe that you are duty bound to not only raise questions in the House with regards the standard of care and the increase in deaths at the War Memorial, but to also put pressure and lobby the Home Secretary to reopen this investigation.

This is what we now expect you to do, anything less will just not be acceptable. The police investigation has been nothing short of a farce and a cover up, the truth must now come out.

I await hearing from you.
