Hi John,

We've been taking another look at this one. We've attempted to cost it ourselves - see the table attached.

We can't see any justification for paying anything prior to 12 April 2011. Do you agree?

We've reduced the solicitors rates to those with 50% uplift (rather than the 90% that they applied). We've also disallowed the travelling and waiting uplifts claimed - in line with our previous appropriation this.

Brief fee we've cut to £2,000.



Its adding up to about £12,800 (so we aren't even reaching the amount the Minister agreed).

It would be really helpful if you could take a look at this in conjunction with the solicitor's request (which we can email to you if the file is not handy).

Sorry for being a pain with this one, but I do think the costs claimed are excessive, and it's incumbent upon us to justify the amount we intend to grant (albeit we now have a slight discrepancy between £12,800 and £15,500!).
