
Thank you for your letter of 20th January.

In response to your points:-

1. I hope by now that witnesses would have been formally warned in accordance with the schedule that we drew up at the Pre-Inquest Hearing.

I have heard from the Royal College of Nursing that Jill Hamblin has serious health problems and she may not be available but I will keep you informed.
