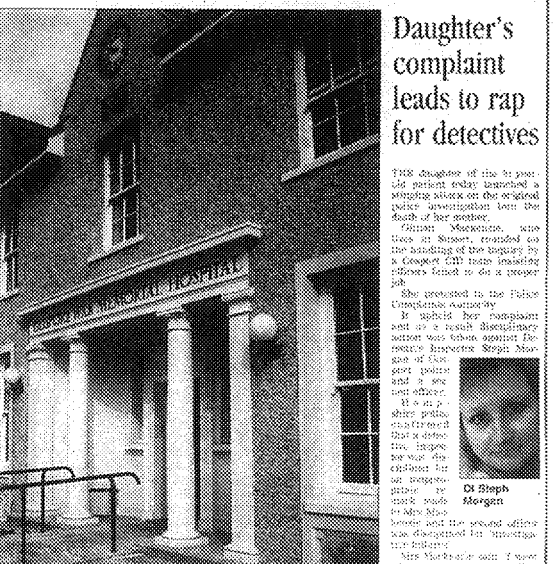
Investigative Superintendent Steve Wicks, who is overseeing the case, refused to comment on the inquiry but said: "I can confirm it is an allegation of unlawful killing."
