

Police investigation into alleged unlawful killing of patient, 91

PROSECUTIONS are examining files concerning the death in hospital of a 91-year-old. *The News* can reveal today.

A full report into allegations that the woman was unlawfully killed in 1988 has been prepared by detectives.

The investigation centres on the Gosport War Memorial Hospital.

Tony Health officials said they were co-operating fully with the police but declined further details.


