Firstly, I would like to thank you for ordering the release of the medical specialist reports by Prof Ford and Dr Mundy. I haven't personally seen them yet but I know that copies are held by Mr Tyrer who attended the second PIR on my behalf. As Mr Tyrer does not have the facilities to scan and email copies to me, I have asked your office (Heather) to do this if at all possible, and I am hopeful that these will show up in the not too distant future.

I have been working through the various papers you had previously supplied in preparation for the inquests, and have noted yet another report that could have an important bearing on the situation. It is a toxicology report by Professor Robert Forrest which, like the other two, was prepared for the benefit of the police investigation.

If this report is already held by you, I would be very grateful if a copy could be forwarded to me and, if not, to also ask that you consider ordering its release from the police.

I would be grateful if you could advise me if there is any further material of any sort involving my step-father (Arthur Denis Brian Cunningham) that I have not been given copies of, especially where copies have or will be supplied to Barton's defence lawyer.
