Dear Graeme and Peter

Someone from the Correspondence Office in the Medical Records Dept rang me today to inform me that a family have been in touch with the Police about their mother, Ann Mayne, who died in 1999 in SMH. The Police have requested a copy of the med recs and say that as the case has been reported to them by the family, they have a duty to make initial enquiries, although they think the enquiry is probably a knee jerk reaction from the GWMH Inquests which have been highly publicised. I have informed Emma Topping as well. We may well receive more enquiries in due course from other families, but thought you would want to know about this one.

I have asked the Correspondence Office to ask the Police to make any enquiries they have about the patient's treatment via me in the first instance, rather than contacting staff members direct and will let you know if they do contact me.
