Someone from the Correspondence Office in the Medical Records Dept rang me today to inform me that a family have been in touch with the Police about their mother, Ann Mayne, who died in 1999 in SMH. The Police have requested a copy of the med recs and say that as the case has been reported to them by the family, they have a duty to make initial enquiries, although they think the enquiry is probably a knee jerk reaction from the GWMH Inquests which have been highly publicised.
