I am Doctor Althea Everestà Geradette LORD and I am currently employed by the East Hants Primary Care Trust as a Community Geriatrician for Fareham and Gosport Primary Care Trust.

I have held this position since the 21st June 2004 (21/06/2004).

In 1978 I graduated from the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Sri Lanka, Colombo. I obtained an MB (Bachelor of Medicine) and a BS (Bachelor of Surgery).

In 1983 I obtained a post graduate qualification as a Doctor of Medicine at the University of Sri Lanka, Colombo.

I worked at the General Hospital, Colombo as a Senior House Officer and a Registrar in General Medicine until May 1984.

From May 1984 I was employed as a Registrar in Nephrology under the supervision of Professor H A LEE at the Renal Unit at St Mary's Hospital, Portsmouth. I held this position until October 1985.

Between October 1985 to September 1988 I was employed as a Registrar in Geriatric Medicine at St Mary's and Queen Alexandra Hospitals, Portsmouth.

From October 1988 until March 1992 I was employed as a Senior Registrar on a rotation between Southampton and Portsmouth Hospitals.

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Continuation of Statement of: LORD, ALTHEA EVERESTA GERADETTE

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From the March 1992 until June 2004 I was employed as a Consultant Geriatrician for the Department of Medicine for older people in Portsmouth. During this period I worked at Queen Alexandra, St Mary's and Gosport War Memorial Hospitals .

In 1997 I obtained a F.R.C.P which is the Fellowship of the Royal College of Physicians.

My General Medical Council Registration Number is **Code A**

Between 1996 and June 2004, as a Consultant Geriatrician, my responsibilities included:-

In-patients at Queen Alexandra Hospital.

In-patients at Daedalus Ward of Gosport War Memorial Hospital.

In-patients at Kingsclere Rehabilitation Ward at St Mary's Hospital.

I also conducted Day Hospital sessions at :-

Amulree Day Hospital at St Mary's Hospital

Dolphin Day Hospital at Gosport War Memorial Hospital

These sessions alternated every week.

In addition I held out-patients sessions weekly at St Mary's Hospital and out-patient sessions on the first, third and fifth weeks at Gosport War Memorial Hospital.

I was consultant for all these patients who required specialist care for their physical health.

All these patients would have been over the age of 65 years.

During 1999 I would have been making weekly ward rounds as consultant responsible for Daedalus Ward of Gosport War Memorial. This together with my out-patient sessions and Dolphin Day Hospital sessions meant that I would attend Gosport War Memorial Hospital at least once, but most often twice a week.

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Another consultant who had similar responsibilities for Dryad Ward of Gosport War Memorial Hospital was Doctor Richard Ian REID .

During any short term absences of Dr REID I would provide cover for his patients on Dryad Ward. This would not have been on a formal ward round basis but I would have responded to any problem, if alerted by the Clinical Assistant, Doctor BARTON or a member of the nursing staff.

On occasion of any long term absence a 'Locum' would have been sought to cover my responsibilities.

I have been asked what involvement I had in the treatment of and the medical condition of a patient called Elsie DEVINE , date of birth 26th June 1911 (26/06/1911).

Mrs DEVINE was an in-patient on Dryad Ward of Gosport War Memorial Hospital from 21st October 1999 (21/10/1999) until her death on 21st November 1999 (21/11/1999).

Mrs DEVINE had been transferred from Queen Alexandra Hospital, Portsmouth having been admitted there on 9th October 1999 (09/10/1999).

I first wish to state that I have no personal recollection of any involvement with Elsie DEVINE.

From 29th September 1999 (29/09/1999) until 15th November 1999 (15/11/1999) I had a long period of sick leave. During this period a Locum Consultant Physician in Geriatrics was appointed to cover my responsibilities. This consultant was Dr W K JAYAWARDENA .

I have examined the medical records of Elsie DEVINE bearing exhibit reference BJC/16.

From my examination of these notes/medical records I have found no entries or notes to indicate that I had any direct contact with Elsie DEVINE or that any contact was made to me regarding

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the care/treatment of this lady.

I note that my name does appear on exhibit BJC/16/PG/18&19 which is a 'Discharge Spell Summary Form'. My name appears against the heading Consultant and shows as Dr A LORD.

I also note from exhibit BJC/16/PG/20&21 a letter from Dr W K JAYAWARDENA to Dr H DUNCAN stating his intention to arrange for Mrs DEVINE to be transferred to Gosport War Memorial Hospital.

This letter is dated 20th October 1999 (20/10/1999) and was during the period that Dr JAYAWARDENA was providing locum cover during my absence.

This could possibly account for my name appearing on this document exhibit BJC/16/PG/18&19.

On the same document against the heading 'Ward' the letters 'Dry' appear. This is an abbreviation for 'Dryad'. 'Dryad Ward' was the responsibility of Dr Richard Ian REID at that time.
